- Type of entity (i.e. tax exempt)
- Tax ID Number

- Use of the funds. How will this request be used saving lives of police officers and/or firefighters in Saginaw County? Please include a list of item(s) along with a description of each item, the cost of each, catalog #, vendor, and contact information
- Name and signature of person authorizing request on behalf of requesting organization
- Contact name and number for follow up questions
